Two parts to designing a function:
1) function definition
2) function invocation

Main function; one main function per program to control how all the other functions invokes.



Functions can contain variables:

Local variable:
Defined inside function

Global variable:
Can be used anywhere

Keyword arguments

have to be a keyword somewhere in the program
